The University of Évora announces the opening of the call for papers for III International Congress on Language, Literature, Wine and Territory: «Wine, teach me all my history» (António Barbosa Bacelar).

Similar to what happened in the first two editions, at the University of Rioja (Spain) and at the University of Piemonte Oriental, in Vercelli (Italy), this third edition of the *III International Conference on Language, Literature, Wine and Territory* aims to bring together renowned experts as well as researchers, integrated in universities, research centres and other institutions, with an identity tradition linked to wine, who wish to present their reflections around the proposed thematic lines. This congress aims to be a meeting point and to share synergies, aiming to bring together institutions and wine regions that share interest in language and literature.
